We have been monitoring your file following the voting process and were just informed you received an FI-1.

FI-4R(02/2021)-Transferred to a Sex Offender Education Program (SOEP) and release to parole after completion and not earlier than 4 months from 02/2021.

This is the chance you have been waiting for, so do not do anything which could cause you to lose it such as receiving a disciplinary action. Your release can easily be withdrawn. My staff and I worked very hard putting together your parole package and representing you before the Board. Do not mess up.

It is very difficult to convince the Board to release an inmate. Continue doing all you can to change, keep a good attitude and remember the ultimate reward of going home. Remember, very few inmates are granted parole.

Once you are released to parole you must abide by all the stipulations and requirements placed upon you. Failure to do so exactly is like asking to be sent pack to prison. Should that occur, the chances of receiving parole again are greatly diminished.

Please be advised that I will be destroying your file in the near future. I do this because of the very personal information contained in your file. This information does not need to be discoverable by any outside agency or individual. If you wish for me to return any information to you prior to destroying the file please contact my office immediately!
